A patented **vertical grain** design further **reduces cracking** and ensures long-term weathering stability.

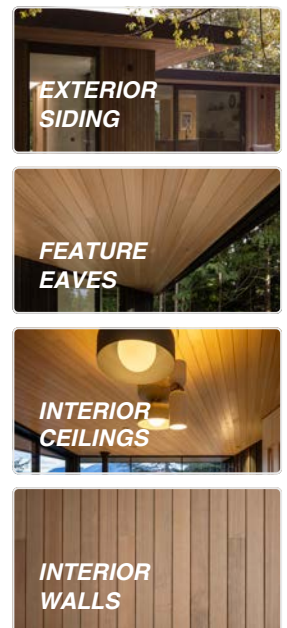

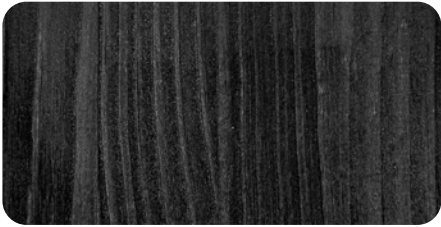

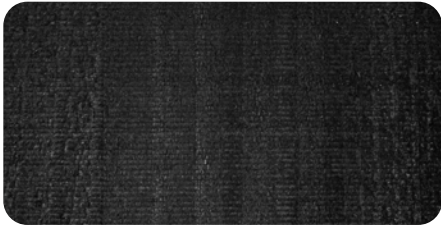

WIRE BRUSHED

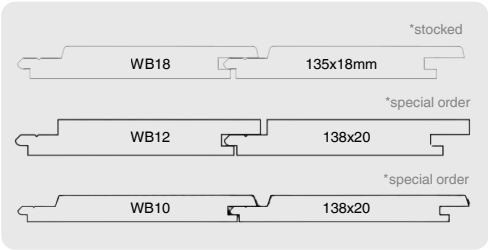
Wire brushed wood has its softer grain brushed away to reveal the harder grain, enhancing the natural patterns with a subtle, weathered texture that feels refined and timeless.



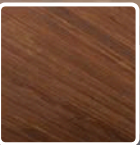
BANDSAWN
